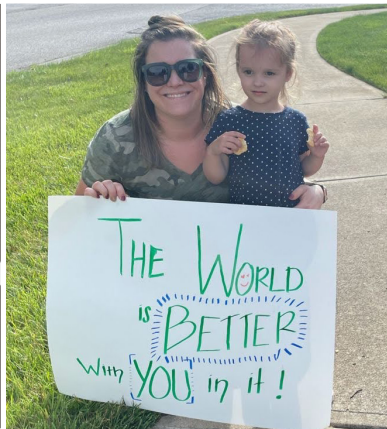

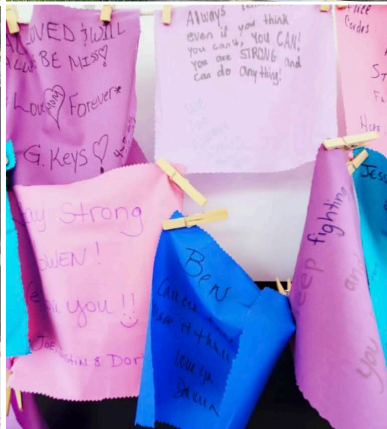
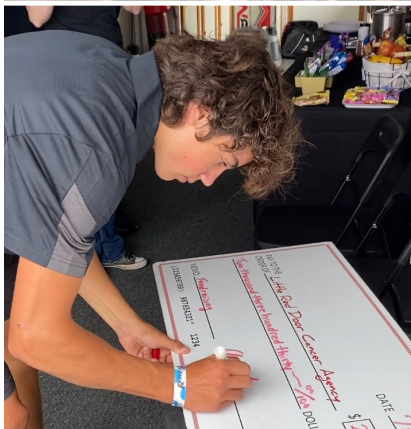

CLIENTS SERVED

We served over 3,100 Hoosiers in 2021 through direct services. In addition to those that received direct navigation, we also served 1,331 clients through our virtual programs and services.



107,717

MEALS

We provided over 107,000 individual meals to cancer patients. Through new partnerships with Gleaners Food Bank and Second Helpings, we provided an additional 1,578 meals in the form of prepared meals and food boxes.



31,668

TRIPS TO TREATMENT

We provided over 31,500 trips to life-saving cancer treatments, at no cost to our clients. A cancer patient's ability to fully comply with and complete their physician's prescribed treatment program is one of the largest contributors to positive outcomes for a cancer diagnosis.

Our Client Services Representatives answered nearly 16,000 phone calls in 2021. Through these conversations we identified barriers to healthcare and connected clients with resources to help them make the most of life and least of cancer.

EMOTIONAL SUPPORT CALLS

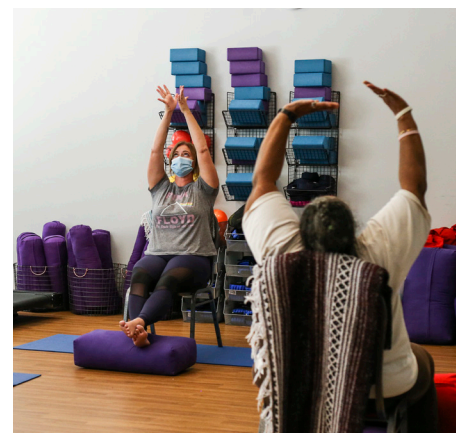
We provided over 708 emotional support calls to cancer patients and caregivers in 2021 in addition to all other navigation calls.

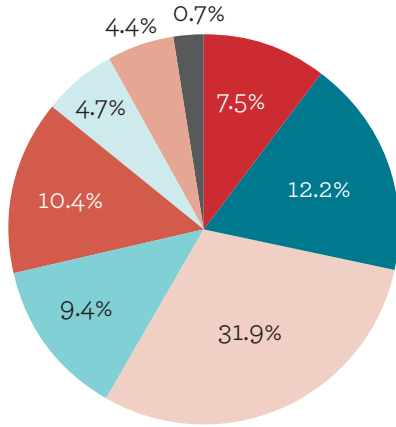
SURVIVORSHIP PROGRAMMING

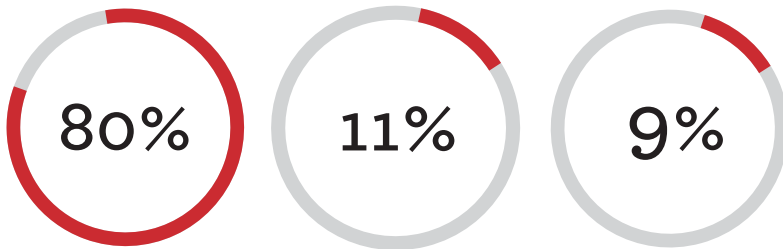

Proceeds from the Face of Hope Breakfasts provide transportation to and from cancer treatments, support services and therapies, nutritional supplements and more to help underserved cancer patients in Indiana make the most of life and the least of cancer. The agency is dependent upon its

success to fuel our mission.

As with most things in 2021, we had to think outside of the box. Using an amended format to protect the health of attendees, we streamed our Face of Hope presentations online via Zoom in addition to our in-person event. Using small-size Zoom rooms allowed friends and coworkers to greet each other before the presentation and preserve a social element of the event. The event's success wouldn't have been possible without the 100 Table Captains that stepped up to serve.

CLIENT NAVIGATION



Navigation is the backbone of the work that takes place each day at Little Red Door.

The new year posed new challenges for our clients and for our Client Services Representatives. Battling the ever-changing COVID-19 pandemic, cancer patients and their caregivers experienced more inconsistency and unpredictability than before. While some aspects of pre-pandemic life began to return, our clients were among the individuals most vulnerable to COVID complications. Some clients were unable to stay connected to their usual caregivers and support systems due to the virus, which limited the amount of support available during cancer treatments, support that was already limited to begin with.

Client Services Representatives answered the call for help by extending additional support through home deliveries and

emotional support conversations. In 2020, the wig boutique transitioned to an online shopping forum which was maintained through 2021. In addition to the online forum, the boutique opened at a limited capacity to in-person fittings again. A free food pantry was established in 2020, The Little Store, which continues to provide additional food sources for clients in need today. Making these programs successful were the Client Services Representatives who embraced innovation and met our clients where they were.

As our Client Services team looks to 2022, we are excited to integrate the changes made in 2021 to a model that allows for more in-person services once we can safely do so. We are looking forward to maintaining and improving upon the virtual activities that were so valuable in 2020. We are excited to be back in hospital treatment centers, where we can be most accessible to our clients when they need us.

Cancer survivors face unique challenges. The side effects of cancer treatment can result in barriers to wellbeing such as pain, reduced strength and flexibility, digestive system issues, lymphedema, fatigue, social isolation, and suppressed immune system. Our Door to Wellness programming offers our clients a space and opportunity to join a community of people facing the same journey and similar challenges. Fitness, nutrition and social connection programming along with side effect management help our clients design their new normal in ways that make sense for them.

Every bit of Door to Wellness programming is designed with the needs and desires of cancer survivors in mind. And perhaps most importantly—it's fun! In the face of COVID we knew just how important these programs and services were for our clients so instead of canceling them all together, we went virtual.

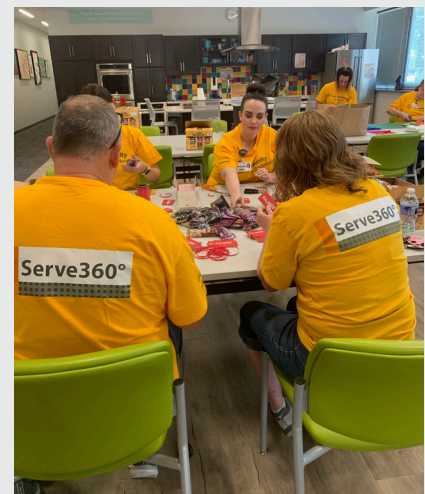

At Little Red Door, our mission is to make the most of life and the least of cancer—for people of all ages.

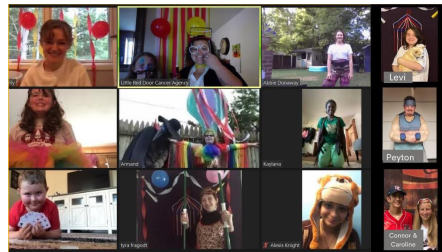
When cancer happens, it affects the entire family—especially for our pediatric clients. Children with cancer are even more dependent on those around them to care for them. At Little Red Door, our mission is to ease the burden that cancer creates for everyone affected. We provide our pediatric clients with the same care as our adult clients, like transportation to and from treatment, nutritional supplements, meals, and door to wellness programming, with the addition of multiple camp activities and experiences throughout the year available to any pediatric oncology patient in the entire state of Indiana at any point in their cancer journey.

This year, like most of the rest of the world, we began adopting hybrid models of our activities and events which included both virtual and in-person components, when safe to do so. Our Youth Services program and Camp Little Red Door activities adopted this model as well. We were excited to continue with most of our virtual camp activities while planning events that safely allow for in-person connections. In 2022, we are excited to continue this further with 26 events over the year, both virtual and in-person.

As 2021 has been just as unpredictable

as 2020, we are thankful that we are able to offer the kids and their families a way to stay in touch with us and each other all year long. We are hopeful that in 2022 we can expand our in-person events further, and we are so excited for the day we can all be together fully in-person again.

Cancer Survivors Day

Transportation program provided over 31,000 rides to cancer treatment



Transportation to cancer treatment is one of the most significant barriers for cancer patients.

Imagine hearing the words “you have cancer”, for everyone, it will stop you in your tracks. Now, imagine being unsure how you will get to and from treatment, if you will even get to treatment. These are fears that Little Red Door clients face each day. Upon diagnosis, Penny was considering forgoing treatment because of the cost of transportation. On average, a cancer patient needs 14 round-trip rides during their treatment. At \$24 a trip, clients will pay more than \$330 for transportation alone. Little Red Door provided Penny with

transportation for the entirety of her treatment, 5 days a week for 7 weeks. Penny is now 2 years cancer free and is one of our most active Door to Wellness participants, attending yoga, massage and crafting every week.

Thanks to philanthropic support, Little Red Door fills the gap for cancer patients like Penny, in need of critical transportation. In 2021, we provided more than 31,000 trips to treatment for clients that have nowhere to turn.

Not only does this provide economic relief for our clients, minimizing the barrier to access treatment has significant positive impact, reducing the risk of recurrence and mortality.
